What will it cost me for my son to play lacrosse?

This is an approximation of what each family can expect to pay per player to participate in Chatfield Lacrosse.

Minimum cost each year (Jeffco Fee, Booster Fee, Gear)

Jeffco Athletic Participation Fee \$185.00 Busses, Refs, Stadium use

General Goal is "Zero Balance" Budgeting (Player Fee Income + Fund Raising = Expense on an annual basis + saving for next uniform purchase)

How does the Booster Club use the Player Fees?

(This is an approximation of how the Fees are spent; full detail is also available for review.)

Annual Costs of Program paid by Annual Player Fee

Business Expense \$2,875.00 bank processing, league lineup, supplies

Off-Season Thank you for Coaches \$3,150.00 Practices and games

Insurance \$650.00 For Booster Board members

"In the Game" \$1,000.00 Families may apply for help in paying costs; application required "Spirit in the Stick" Scholarship \$1,000.00

Graduating Seniors compete for a scholarship paid to a 2 or 4 yr school Pictures \$1,100.00 Team/Player pictures taken in spring and in-game photos

Coach Hiring Fee \$450.00 \$164 CHSSA req'd fees: certification, background check, CPR. renews every 2 years Team Equipment Supplies \$1,000.00 Balls, nets, chalk, first aid equip, et al

Field / Facility Rental \$1,200.00 Includes winter indoor practice space (Fieldhouse or similar) Helmet Decals \$240.00 New decals will be provided to all players

Game Filming / Score Break \$2,625.00 Varsity & JV games

Team Building Events \$1,000.00 Team dinners & outings

Coaches' Apparel \$1,600.00 approximately \$190 per coach for apparel, approximately 8 coaches Shooter Shirts \$1,700.00 32 at approx \$39 each

Senior Day Gifts/Senior Game Night \$1,920.00 Approximately \$70 each for gifts/roses and banners for game Build Uniform Funds \$3,500.00

Money put away each year with target of new uniform set each 4 years Banquet Awards \$325.00 ~15 awards

End of Season Yearbook \$800.00 Design & Printing

Misc \$1,850.00 Miscellaneous and other expenses

\$27,985.00

If we have 63 players in the program, the funding needed per player is: \$444.21

The Player Fee is set at \$400; the difference needs to be made up by fundraising contribution to the Club by each Player

Examples of possible fundraising opportunities are:

Poker Night Annually: \$1,000 goes to Club

If use King Soopers Loyalty Program at rate of \$30 / quarter Annually: \$120 goes to LAX CASH

FYI: Not included in the summary above is the money collected directly from player and then spent directly on player - Examples include: off-season league fees, Tournament fees, player gear, Spring Break costs (reservations, tickets, games, refs, etc)
